## Welcome back to Year 4

## Uniform

Please make sure their books and records are sent back to school with them every day.

# **Timestables**

Within Year 4, we have a big focus on timestables due to our Multiplication Check in June 2024. We will have daily times tables lessons and regular sound checks in preparation for the check. It is expected that for the test, children will know all of their times table up to 12x12. We are expecting children to regularly practice their times tables at home using Timestables Rockstars. We appreciate your support in this area.

#### Homework and spellings

Homework will be set every Friday through Microsoft Teams. This can be completed online and should be shared with your teacher by Wednesday, unless specified otherwise. The first homework will be set on 15th September. Spellings will also be sent out on a Friday and will link to the common exception words that will be included within our writing throughout the year.
